
BELTED GALLOWAY



Our Belted Galloway are from Oinri Jackson's Brittas Estate in Nobber Co. Meath, former home of Captain Bligh.

The Belted Galloway is a heritage beef breed of cattle, originating from Scotland. Historically, these cattle were not kept in sheds in the Scottish winters, and thus they have evolved into a hardy, adaptable breed with good foraging ability, easy calving and the capacity to thrive in conditions where other breeds struggle.

Belted Galloways are primarily raised for their quality marbled beef, although they are sometimes milked and purchased to adorn pastures due to their striking appearance. The Beltie produces high quality beef, which is lean and tasty. The meat is nicely marbled, but is otherwise lower in superfluous fat.

A minimum of 28 days maturing ensures deep and rich flavour.
